

Management for Travel and Tourism Levels 4 and 5

Key management and sector specific content will provide learners with the knowledge and understanding to succeed in this expanding industry.

Travel and tourism is the fastest growing industry in the world (partly due to the increase of international globalisation and business travel) and these qualifications are in response to the escalating demand for managers with a strong understanding of the travel and tourism sector.

There are 2 different sizes for each level of these qualifications, Certificate (30 credits) and the Diploma (60 credits). These qualifications are regulated by Ofqual.

You can start at any level or size depending on your experience or prior qualifications, and once you have completed the level 5 Diploma, you can progress to study an Extended Diploma at the same level in another subject area, which provides progression to a Bachelors Degree Top-up in a variety of areas. you can progress to study the final year of a bachelor degree at university or a range of ATHE level 6 Diplomas.

Level 5 Diploma Core Units

- Travel and Tourism Organisations in a Global Context

- People Management

There is also a range of optional units for both Extended Diplomas which allow specialisms and complete the required 60 credits.
